No.-6/Stha-Nyaya-610/2001 ka- 1999 /In exercise of powers conferred by Article-233 read with Article-309 of the Constitution of India and all provisions of Law enabling in that behalf the Governor of Jharkhand, after consultation with the High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi, a Notification has been issued by the Department vide Notification no.- 6/Stha-Nyaya-610/2001 ka-7974, dated 14.12.2011 with effect from the date of its issuance. But in view of order dated 20th April, 2010 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India passed in I.A. No.-77 arising out of W.P.(C) No.-1022 of 1989 as well as in Civil Appeal (C) No.-1867 of 2006 and also the recommendation of the Hon'ble Jharkhand High Court, Ranchi the Notification no.- 6/Stha-Nyaya-610/2001 ka-7974, dated 14.12.2011 has to be effective from 01.01.2011.

So, the amendments in Rule 4, 5 and 8(d) of the Jharkhand Superior Judicial Service (Recruitment, Appointment and Conditions of Service) Rule, 2001 made by the Departmental Notification No.- 6/Stha-Nyaya-610/2001 ka-7974, dated 14.12.2011 will be effective from 01.01.2011.

All other contents of the Notification No.-7974, dated 14.12.2011 will remain unchanged.


