No.-6/Bibidh-808/2002 Ka-³⁴²⁸...../In exercise of powers conferred by Article-234 read with Article-309 of the Constitution of India and all provisions of law enabling in that behalf the Governor of Jharkhand, after consultation with the High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi, is pleased to make following amendments in the Jharkhand Judicial Service (Recruitment) Rules-2004 :-

(1) **Short title and commencement**

- (i) These rules may be called 'Jharkhand Judicial Service (Recruitment) Amendment Rules, 2012.'
- (ii) It will take effect from the date of notification.

(2) **Amendment of word 'Subordinate' in the Rules**

Wherever in the Rules, the word 'subordinate' is mentioned, the same shall be deleted, so that the Judicial Officers of the State belong to the common category though there may be grade amongst them.

(3) **Change in nomenclature of Civil Judge Junior Division or Munsif as Civil Judge and that of Civil Judge (Senior Division) as Senior Civil Judge.**

Wherever in the Rules, Civil Judge (Junior Division) or Munsif is mentioned, the same shall be read as Civil Judge and wherever the word Civil Judge (Senior Division) is mentioned, the same shall be read as Senior Civil Judge.

(4) **Deletion of the last parts of Rule 3(b) and 5(a)**


The last parts of Rule 3(b) and 5(a) of Jharkhand Judicial Service (Recruitment) Rules 2004 relating to direct appointment of Members

of Bar (Advocates having a minimum of 5 years experience in Bar to the post of Civil Judge (Senior Division) (Subordinate Judge) are deleted.

(5) **Deletion of the word Civil Judge (Senior Division) (Subordinate Judge) appearing in preamble and para-18, 21(a), 21(b) and 22 of Jharkhand Judicial Service (Recruitment) Rules-2004**

The word "Civil Judge Senior Division (Subordinate Judge)" appearing in the preamble of Jharkhand Judicial Service (Recruitment) Rules-2004 (Notification No.-6/Bibidh-808/2002/977 dated the 31st March, 2005), and in para-18, 21(a), 21(b) and 22 of the said Rules, are deleted.


